Our Mission

Langley Residential Support Services serves adults with developmental disabilities, their families and our communities by providing quality, comprehensive residential and community support services. We believe everyone deserves the chance to live a rich, full life.

Our History

Langley Residential was created from a desire to care for and support adults with developmental disabilities in an environment that was very much like a family home.

In the early 1980s, members of three McLean churches (Trinity United Methodist, Immanuel Presbyterian and Lutheran Church of the Redeemer) chaperoned monthly dances sponsored by the ARC of Northern Virginia. After getting to know some of the young adults with developmental disabilities who attended these dances, they became concerned about what would happen to these vulnerable individuals after their parents could no longer care for them.

Studies at the time showed a growing need for smaller community residences where these individuals could live in a shared home with their peers and develop the skills important to day-to-day living.

Our founders wanted to create such an environment and opened our first group home in 1985. We continue to carry out this mission today—and support 55 adults through the operation of six homes and a large community support drop-in services program in the Fairfax County-Falls Church City area.

The Individuals We Serve

Langley currently works with 55 adults with developmental disabilities through our residential and community support (drop-in services) programs. We offer two types of residential programs—intensive and supportive. Currently, 24 individuals live in our homes. There are another 31 people in our drop-in program. More than 90% of the folks we serve are over 45 years old and slightly more than half are women.

The individuals we serve are unique. All have been diagnosed with a developmental disability; however, the level or impact of the disability is different for each person. Everyone faces their own challenges. This means that some people are able to live on their own with minimal support, while others need a more supervised environment. Skill levels vary and sometimes regress with age. Nevertheless, all of them are able to achieve more than they thought they could—and this is where our work begins.

How We Make a Difference

Our programs and services help adults with developmental disabilities realize their dreams to have lives that are like those of everyone else. They dream of:

1. **Living on their own:** As they move past childhood and adolescence, many people with developmental disabilities want to leave the family home just like they've seen their brothers or sisters do. They want to be as independent as they possibly can and to have a place to live that they can call their own.

With support from our counselors, the people we work with are able to live in a place of their own choosing—whether it is a Langley residence, their own home or their family's home. They take great pride in being able to maintain a clean home, cook meals, do laundry, grocery shop and do all the other chores of daily life that many of us perform without much thought.

2. **Having meaningful relationships:** They want to feel included. In the evenings or on the weekend, they look forward to seeing their friends or meeting new people when our Direct Support Professionals (DSPs) accompany them to basketball, bowling, book club, church and other activities available in their community.

Going to places they enjoy, doing things that interest them, and seeing people who value them is vital to their emotional well-being. It makes them feel that they are part of and contribute to the fabric of their community.

3. **Having a job and making a contribution:** Many of the people in our program have jobs. Being employed enables them to feel productive and valued. They take pride in the fact that they go to work and earn a paycheck just like most adults.

However, in order to experience success in the workplace, a person must first be proficient in certain life skills that make him/her employable. Included among these skills are: managing daily routines to ensure proper rest, nutrition and punctuality, plus navigating the transportation system (bus, van, etc.) to and from work. This is where our DSPs have the greatest impact—teaching and reinforcing these life skills so that people can reach their potential.

Auction Instructions

Langley Residential's online auction opens on Monday, October 5 at 12:00 noon and closes at 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 10. During the final hour of the last evening of the auction (7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 10), we will host a livestreamed online session for live auction bidding and wine tastings with connoisseur Victor Mendes of Vienna Vintner, which has supported our charity for many years. Langley Residential will send out links to the auction and the livestreamed event; this information will be available via our website, e-mail list and Facebook page.

You can order wine packages for the tastings until 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 8 at \$100 each (\$50 is tax-deductible). You can pick up the wine at Vienna Vintner from Saturday, October 3 through Saturday, October 10 but your purchase must be made through Langley Residential. Please call us at 703-893-0068 ext. 1800 to place your order for wine packages.

We are excited to tell you that our auction has gone mobile this year! Langley Residential's Uncorking a Rich, Full Life! will be using Handbid, a mobile silent-auction platform that allows you to bid from your smartphone or computer. Below are instructions for smartphones; you can also access the auction through your computer by going to events.handbid.com and searching on "Langley Residential Support Services" or "Uncorking a Rich, Full Life!"

You must create an account and enter a credit card number to bid—but there is no admission fee to access the auction. You don't pay anything unless you place the winning bid on an item.

Here's All You Need to Do to Get Started.

Step 1: Download The Handbid App. If you have an iPhone or Android, you can download the Handbid App from the Apple iTunes App Store or the Google Play store. Please note that Handbid strongly recommends that you "Accept notifications from this app" when you open it and join an auction. This will allow you to get push notifications for "Outbid" messages letting you know that someone has bid a greater amount than you. You can also use Handbid through your computer at events.handbid.com.

Step 2: Tap Get Started & Create Account. Next, you can create an account and you will need to enter a credit card number to bid. Keep in mind there is no admission fee to access the auction; you don't pay anything unless you place the winning bid on an item. From the App home screen, tap on the GET STARTED button and complete the information (please use your cell phone as the phone number). Tap NEXT. Then, Handbid will text you a 5-digit code. Enter this code to log in.


STEP 3: SELECT AUCTION FROM LIST & START BIDDING. Select Langley Residential's "Uncorking a Rich, Full Life!" from the list of auctions and swipe left to enter the auction. Once in the auction, swipe left/right to access categories and up/down to access items.

Whether you are bidding through your computer or in the Handbid App, here are some easy tips to help:

- **MAX BID:** This is the maximum you are willing to spend for an item and the Handbid system will automatically bid for you until you reach your maximum. Set a maximum bid and enjoy your evening!
- **NOTIFICATIONS:** If you have downloaded the Handbid App and accepted push notifications, you will be notified by push notifications when you are outbid on an item. If you don't have the App, you will receive text messages from Handbid.
- **DASHBOARD:** Monitor what you are currently winning and losing on the Dashboard screen in your App or online.

No smartphone? No problem!

You will be able to access the auction through a web browser at events.handbid.com.



If you are having issues with downloading the App or registering, please contact Langley Residential development staff at 703-893-0068 x1800.

PLEASE NOTE: Some auction items were left over from the 2019 auction and thus must be redeemed before the end of 2020. Each item's profile will have redemption information, so please read carefully. Also, some items must be picked up from the Langley Residential office; not all items can be shipped. Each item listing will note how winning bidders can get the items they've won.


